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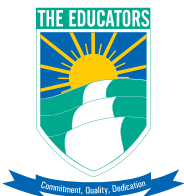

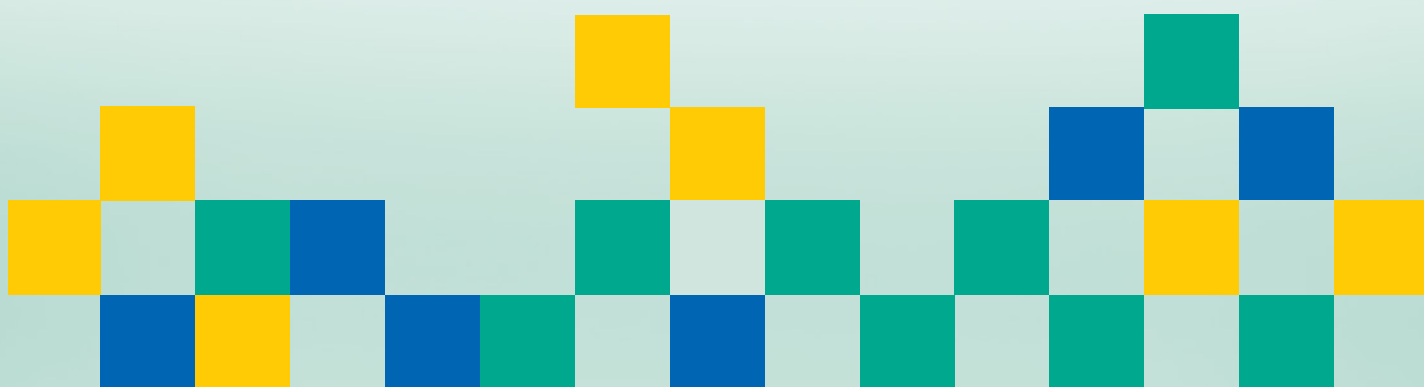

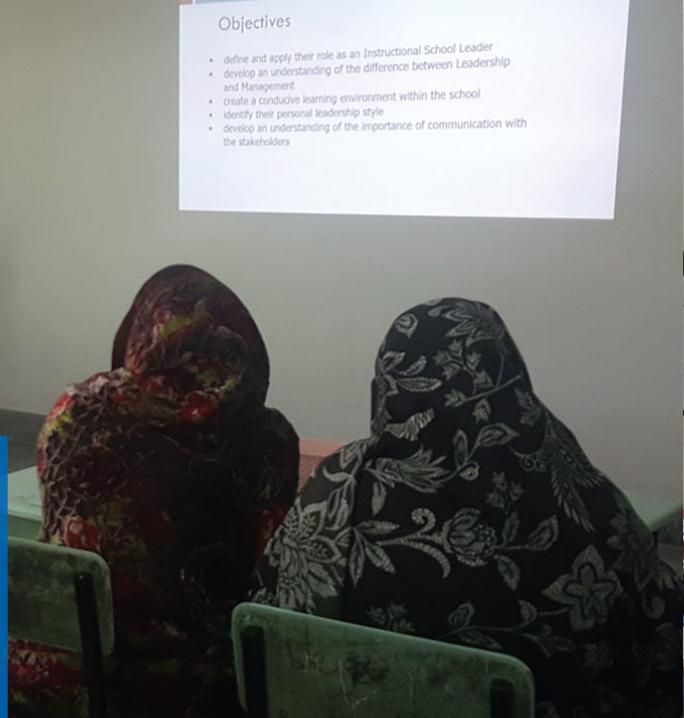
### 'THE EDUCATORS' and Concordia Colleges signed MOU with Noon Academy

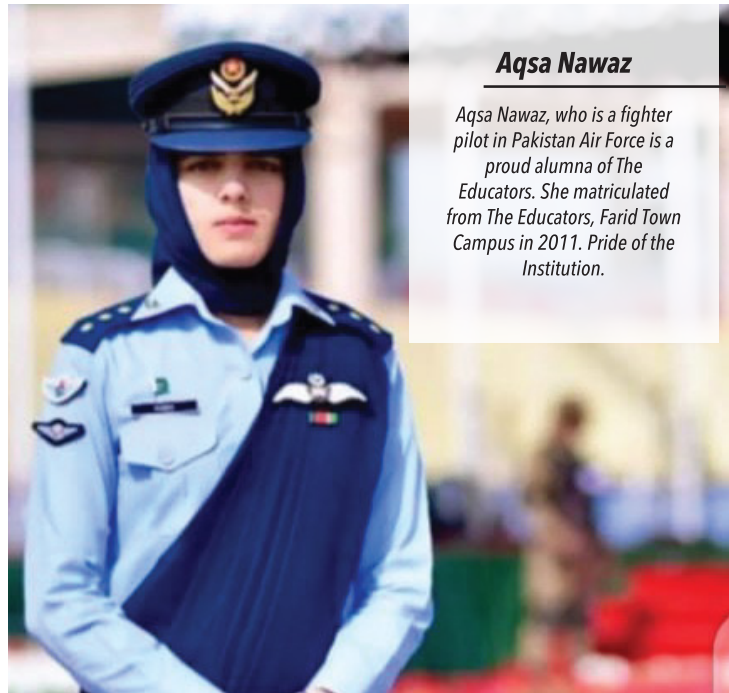

Komal Bavani completed her matriculation from Siddiq Bawani Campus, Tando Adam. She achieved 1st position in the Global ACCA examination.



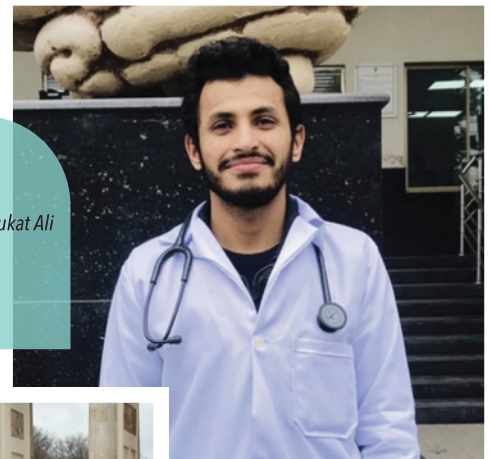
## **Aqsa Nawaz**

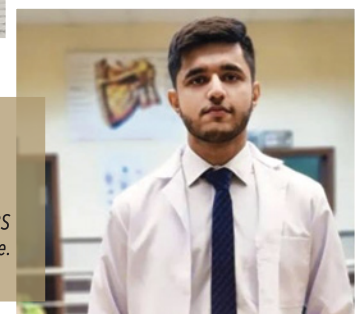

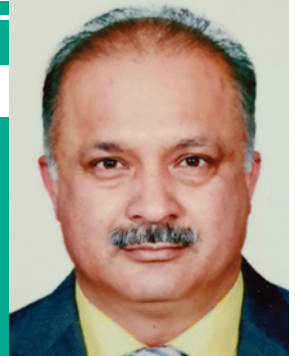

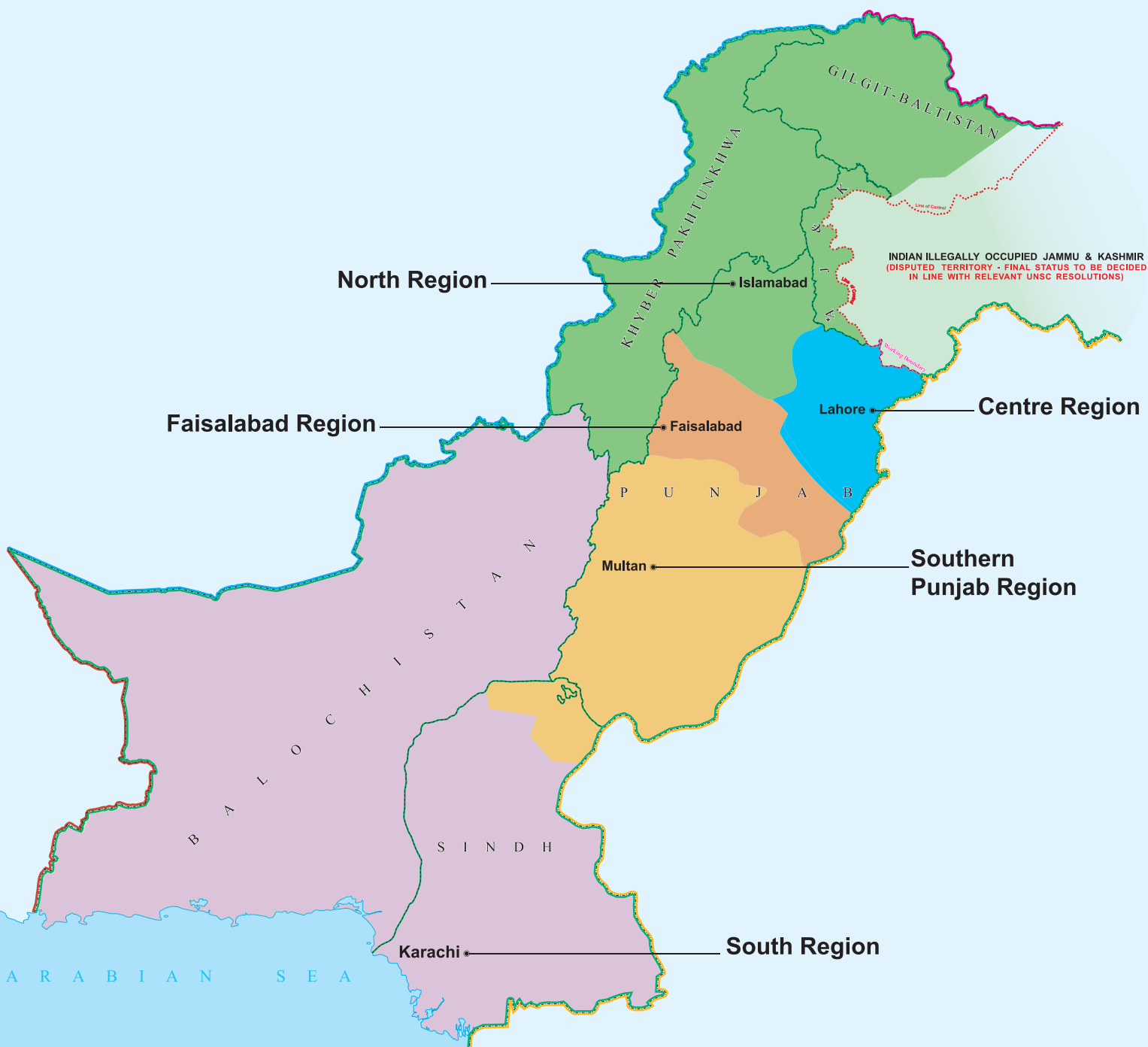
