

FRANEWORK FINANCE ENVIRONMENT OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PROPERTY

'THE EDUCATORS' - Early Years Framework (TE-EYF) rollout commenced in March 2024 and has been successfully implemented across all Preschools (PG - KG) and schools (Class I - II).

To support teachers in effectively implementing TE-EYF, a comprehensive support programme has been established. This programme includes: Online support sessions to provide teachers with opportunities to learn about the framework, ask questions and share best practices; Model teaching videos to showcase effective implementation strategies for various TE-EYF components; Support visits by Regional and Head Office personnel to provide targeted support to teachers where required.

In the first year of implementation, five key teaching strategies have been prioritised through Thematic Lesson Plans (TLPs) and Daily Lesson Plans (DLPs). These strategies include: 5-Step Model for introducing new letters/words/numbers/ حرف یا لفظ; Pair work; Group work; Pair reading; Group reading.

The continued cooperation of Business Partners and School Heads is essential to ensure the ongoing success of the TE-EYF framework.


'THE EDUCATORS' 20th Annual Speech and Debate Competition (National Level) was held on 24th January 2024 at the Pearl Continental, Lahore.
