TRAINING - THE ENGINE THAT DRIVES US FORWARD

At The Educators, we aim to equip our teachers with the necessary skills, knowledge, and competencies to effectively teach and support students' learning. Every year, The Educators trains close to 5,000 teachers across our vast network.

THE EDUCATORS New Titles Training

The Head Office Academics Team provides comprehensive support and training for new book titles. The HO Academics Team conducted 92 face-to-face training sessions across all five regions for the Single National Curriculum and TE titles for classes PG till VIII. These sessions were attended by more than 2,000 participants and were well received. For classes 9 and 10, over 1,600 participants joined our online orientation and discussion sessions that covered all secondary subjects. Regional and HO teams conducted on-demand training, including inductions, orientations, classroom management, teaching strategies, subject knowledge, and school leadership.

Maximize - Professional Development Redefined

The Educators has developed a comprehensive professional development training programme - MAXIMIZE to equip our teachers with the latest research, teaching methodologies, and educational trends. 21 training modules are offered in the MAXIMIZE programme, each with its own considered learning outcomes. The modules cover all strands and are not just limited to teaching and learning but also include school leadership and improvement. This year, The Educators has introduced five new modules; Save Our Stars, Urdu Phonics, Takhiyul Say Tehreer Tak, Developing Receptive Skills in Pre-School, and Developing Productive Skills in Pre-School. Furthermore, based on the feedback received from our business partners, school heads, teachers, and regional teams, TE Head Office Academics Team has revamped and improved all the existing modules in the MAXIMIZE programme.

Specialise - Subject-Specific Training

The Educators Specialise Teacher Training Programme is designed to develop teachers' subject knowledge, enabling them to become more effective educators. The programme aims to enhance the participants' teaching skills, focusing on specific subject areas. The training covers the latest teaching techniques, subject-specific pedagogy, and assessment strategies. By focusing on the particular needs of our teachers, the programme provides a customised approach to professional development, enabling participants to gain the knowledge and skills they need to excel in their subject areas. The programme is structured to be practical and hands-on, with opportunities for participants to demonstrate their newly acquired skills in the classroom. After the successful launch of phase 1 (online), 11 modules in the Specialise Programme will be launched for face-to-face training after summer 2023.



Executive Online Orientation

In May 2023, the Head Office Academics Team organised four Executive Online Orientation sessions for business partners and school heads. These sessions aimed to facilitate the participants in gaining an understanding of important procedures and practices, academic policies, deliverables, interventions, manuals, as well as teaching and learning practices (including classroom observation and notebook checking) for the 2023-24 academic session. With 350+ actively engaged participants, it was an enlightening and interactive learning experience.

Practical Training Workshops

At The Educators, laboratory experimental work is vital for science subjects, providing hands-on experience and fulfilling Board Examination requirements. Teachers play a pivotal role in facilitating practicals. The Head Office conducted Practical Training workshops at Beaconhouse School System to enhance teachers' practical teaching skills and knowledge. These sessions, attended by 30+ teachers at Beaconhouse Garden Town Campus in May 2023, help maintain high standards of quality, setting us apart from competitors.

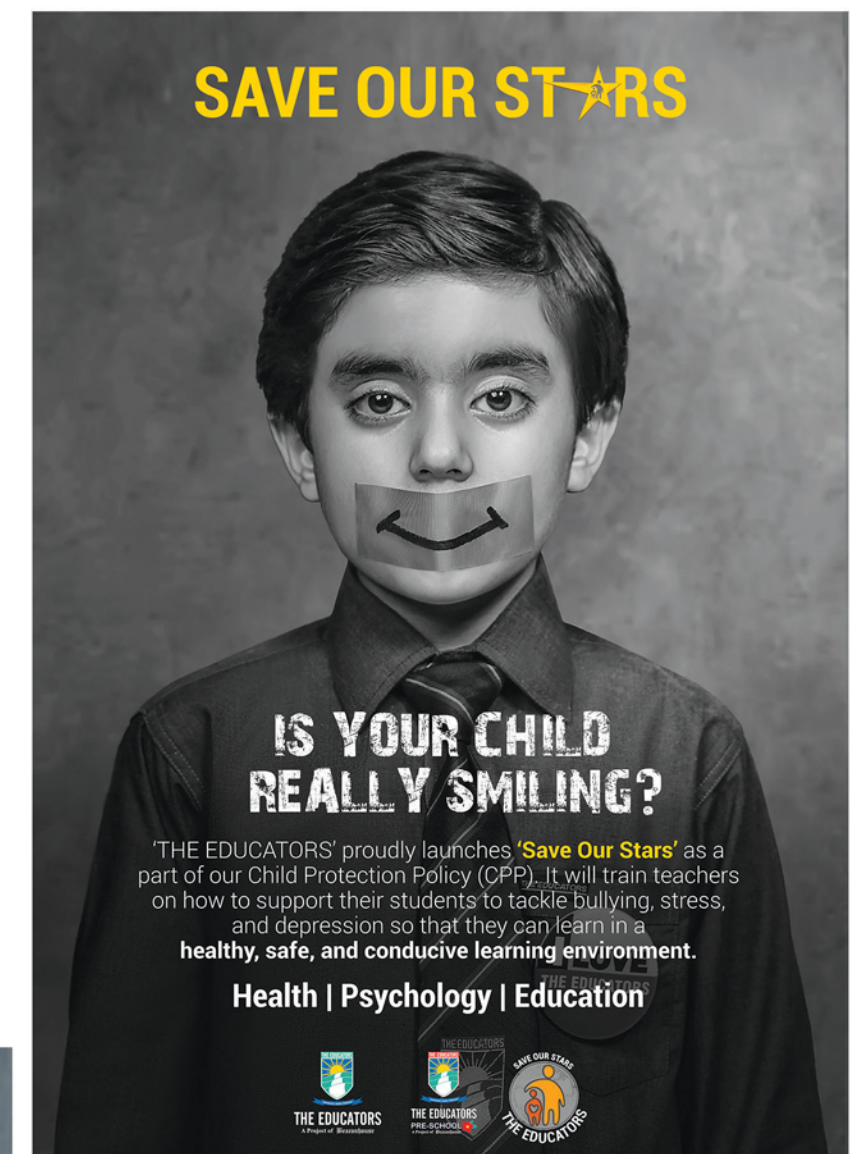
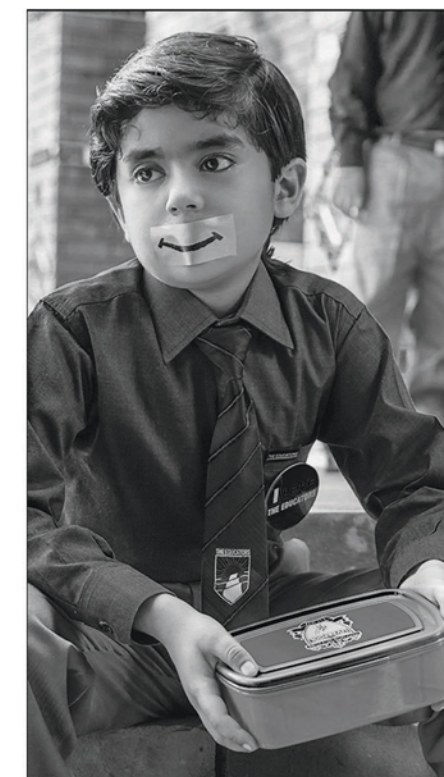

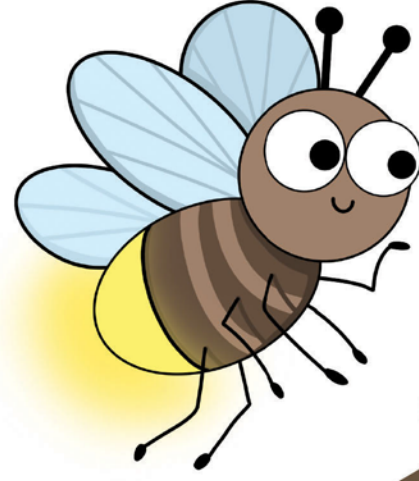
All TE interventions are scaled up after a rigorous testing and piloting phase where key learning and feedback from our stakeholders is incorporated into the intervention which is then implemented across TE's vast branch network. In order to ensure that the highest standards are maintained throughout the implementation phase, each TE intervention has a focal person within the Academics Team both at the Regional and Head Office levels.

SAVE OUR STARS

AWARD WINNING INITIATIVE ON STUDENT SAFETY AND WELLBEING

For a learner there is a close linkage between academic achievement and mental, physical, and psychological wellbeing. To create awareness about the importance of students' emotional and psychological needs and how these impact student academic performance, The Educators has initiated "SAVE OUR STARS"; an integral part of our Child Protection Policy (CPP). The objective of this initiative is to educate teachers on how to best identify and support their students in tackling bullying, managing stress and anxiety so that students can thrive in a healthy, safe, and conducive learning environment. The intervention has recently been awarded the Best Digital Campaign of the Year (Small Budget) at the Pakistan Digital Awards Ceremony held in Karachi in June 2023. 981 teachers from 215 campuses registered for both online and onsite orientation sessions for the "SAVE OUR STARS" initiative. Since its roll out, over 36 training sessions have been conducted and over 33,759 students have benefitted across Pakistan. (All statistics are of February 2023)

LIGHTING THE WAY FOR MASTERY IN URDU SPELLINGS



طلبہ کی مجموعی صلاحیتوں کو نکھارتے ہوئے انہیں پروان چڑھانا دی ایجوکیٹرز کی اولین ترجیحات میں شامل ہے۔ اس سلسلے میں دی ایجوکیٹرز کی جانب سے متعدد ایسے پروگرام متعارف کروائے گئے ہیں جو طلبہ کی سیکھنے کی صلاحیتوں کو بہتر بناتے ہوئے انہیں تعلیمی میدان میں مسلسل آگے بڑھنے کے مواقع فراہم کر رہے ہیں۔ ”ہجّوں کے جگنو“ بھی اسی سلسلے کی ایک کڑی ہے۔ عام مشاہدہ ہے کہ انگریزی کی نسبت اردو الفاظ میں طلبہ کو حروف کے توڑ جوڑ میں مشکل کا سامنا ہوتا ہے، جس کی بنا پر اکثر املا کی اغلاط اور محدود ذخیرہ الفاظ جیسے مسائل کا سامنا کرنا پڑتا ہے۔ یہی مسائل طلبہ کی اردو بولنے، پڑھنے اور لکھنے کی صلاحیتوں پر اثر انداز ہوتے ہوئے اپنے اثرات چھوڑتے ہیں۔ یکساں قومی نصاب کے نفاذ کے بعد اردو کی اہمیت کو پیش نظر رکھتے ہوئے ان مسائل کے تدارک کے لیے ”ہجّوں کے جگنو“ کا آغاز کیا گیا۔ اس پروگرام کا مقصد طلبہ میں ہجّوں سے الفاظ بنانے کی مشق کو پختہ بنانا، اردو ذخیرہ الفاظ میں اضافہ کرنا اور اردو پڑھنے اور لکھنے کی بنیادوں کو استحکام بخشتے ہوئے انہیں تعلیمی میدان میں معاونت فراہم کرنا ہے۔ تعلیمی سال 2022 میں 147 سکولوں سے کے جی اور جماعت اول کے 12,838 طلبہ نے ”ہجّوں کے جگنو“ کے مقابلے میں حصہ لیا اور شاندار کارکردگی کا مظاہرہ کیا۔ تعلیمی سال 2023 میں جماعت دوم بھی اس مقابلے کا حصہ ہے۔ اساتذہ کے بہترین فیڈ بیک اور طلبہ میں اس پروگرام کی افادیت کو مد نظر رکھتے ہوئے آئندہ تعلیمی سالوں میں ”ہجّوں کے جگنو“ کا دائرہ کار جماعت پنجم تک وسیع کیا جائے گا۔

The Intervention “I am an Entrepreneur” was introduced and successfully piloted in the South Region for the academic year 2022-23 and will be implemented across all regions of The Educators in the academic cycle 2023-24. The intervention aims to encourage and motivate students to create their own professional paths and income streams; working for themselves to develop goods and / or services that people may express a demand for. We hope that “I am an Entrepreneur” develops the next generation of young, enterprising, and ambitious entrepreneurs.



Act to Impact - Keeping Community Service at the Centre!

TE's intervention “Act to Impact” encourages students to hone their observational skills, find a need in their context / society, and use their voice and practical efforts to address that gap. “Act to Impact” creates a culture to develop, enhance and showcase critical thinking and leadership skills in students that will be an integral part of their professional careers. Through the “Act to Impact” intervention The Educators also provides a platform to create healthy competition for its students where they can showcase their skills at the national and international levels. The objective of this intervention is to inculcate key principles of leadership and teamwork such as responsibility, helpfulness, self-control, independence, and respect in students. By partnering with HIVE Pakistan's Community Innovation Lab, student projects and initiatives for TE's “Act to Impact”, may be given funding and scaled up to reach a wider audience to make a more profound impression.





ACADEMIC PARTNERSHIPS

SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT PLAN - COLLABORATIONS WITH THE SCHOOL EVALUATION UNIT

In close collaboration with the Beaconhouse School Evaluation Unit (SEU), The Educators provides its business partners with rigorous and robust evaluation, monitoring, and review solutions. Through the SEU Team's extensive on site visit and report, TE offers its business partners a premium programme that identifies areas for improvement and facilitates the processes by which schools may chart out their customised roadmaps towards growth and excellence.

TE's objective as always is to improve the quality of teaching and learning and to facilitate principals and business partners with the tools needed to take improved educational and business decisions.

With the successful launch of the SEU and TE collaborative programme, six TE schools have already benefitted from the SEU Visit and the customised School Development Plan that follows:

The SEU focuses on four dimensions:

1. Effective School Leadership & Management
2. Quality Teaching and Learning
3. A Safe and Caring Environment
4. Quality Planning and Operational Management

BSS - SLATE - SUBJECT LEADER ADVANTAGE AT THE EDUCATORS

The Educators is proposing a partnership between TE and Beaconhouse wherein experienced Subject Leaders (SLs) in Beaconhouse schools may provide training (outlined in the Specialise and Maximize programmes) to subject teachers across The Educators branch network for the development of their subject specific knowledge and skills. The proposal to engage subject leaders from various Beaconhouse branches to deliver training from the Specialise and Maximize programmes is an endeavour to ensure that teachers at even the most remote TE branches shall interact and learn from experienced Beaconhouse trainers with exceptional subject knowledge. While offering the increased engagement that is afforded by introducing new trainers into the mix, this effort will keep the quality of learning and professional development at the highest level.



PRACTITIONER ENRICHMENT AND LEADERSHIP (PEAL) - CONTEXTUALISED LEARNING AT LUMS

The Educators joined hands with the Lahore University of Management Sciences (LUMS) for a professional development programme on leadership, where our business partners were given opportunities to unpack and explore Bolmen and Deal's Four Frames Model of Leadership. The course was specifically designed in collaboration with the LUMS School of Education (SoE) after the LUMS team conducted a thorough situational analysis and engaged with key stakeholders. Through this course, participants acquired the necessary skills and knowledge to create school-specific improvement plans that address their complex problems and needs. Punctuated with high-teas and networking dinners, 62 business partners attended the 2 day-training in two separate cohorts. The PEAL training laid a great foundation for future collaborations between TE and the LUMS SoE.





THE EARLY YEARS FRAMEWORK AND TEACHERS' MANUAL - STRUCTURED APPROACHES IN THE EARLY YEARS

In the pursuit of achieving our goals of quality education for young learners and quality training for our teachers, The Educators Head Office Early Years (EYs) collaborated with the LUMS School of Education (SoE), to develop an Early Years Framework (EYF) model that will add value while catering to the pedagogy and economic considerations of practitioners and equip our teachers with strategies to manage 21st century challenges.

Following research and branch visits conducted by the LUMS SoE, the final draft of the framework lays out key aspects of learning and development and integrates resources, practices, and learning goals from the Pre-School Schemes of Work to enrich the learning process of our children.

To supplement the TE-EYF, the LUMS team also designed the "Teachers' Manual" (TM) which outlines the roles, tools, and strategies for effective and efficient classrooms.

The EYF and TM will be rolled out officially in the Academic Session 2024-25. We at TE believe that our young learners will benefit greatly from the collaborative endeavours and partnerships between TE and other established organisations across the educational landscape.

In order to support TE teachers in implementing the EY Framework, the first video in a series of many on Circle Time has been recorded and used in the EY Induction Course Module. The purpose of the video on Circle Time is to focus on the five key skills that emerge during Circle Time i.e. thinking, listening, looking, speaking, and concentrating. The next video in this series that support framework implementation will be on Story Time.



MOU SIGNING CEREMONY HIVE AND THE EDUCATORS

The Educators partnered with HIVE Pakistan on June 14, 2023 to provide support and facilitation to the students of TE and Concordia Colleges who are working on their community service projects under the initiative of THE EDUCATORS - ACT TO IMPACT.

HIVE is a social-impact organisation working to address issues of extremism and marginalisation through community-led research, facilitative grant-making, upstream mobilisation, innovative campaigning, needs-based mentorship, and participatory collaborations such as Community Innovation Lab – CIL upholding the vision of Mr. Ali Raza, Group Director Beaconhouse.

Through this partnership, HIVE Pakistan will be providing support to The Educators students' projects by providing micro-funding, adaptive capacity support, and mutual earning (where applicable). The HIVE team will work collaboratively with The Educators to ensure the success of the projects and the fulfillment of the students' visions.

Key themes of projects would be climate change, peace, interfaith harmony, violence, women's rights, and fake news / disinformation.
